

In order to assure collaborative relationships between the families that we serve, the Board of Education and the district personnel, as well as to enable parents, guardians and citizens to serve as active partners in the education process, the Superintendent shall develop and implement administrative procedures to:

- 1) Keep parents and guardians informed about their child's school and education
- 2) Establish an effective two-way communication system between all families, the Board of Education and District personnel.
- 3) Seek the advice of parents/guardians on school governance issues and methods to employ in fulfilling the District's educational mission.
- 4) Encourage parent/guardian participation and involvement on how they can assist in their child's learning

Each school operating within the District shall establish a Parent Compact specific to the needs of the school.
