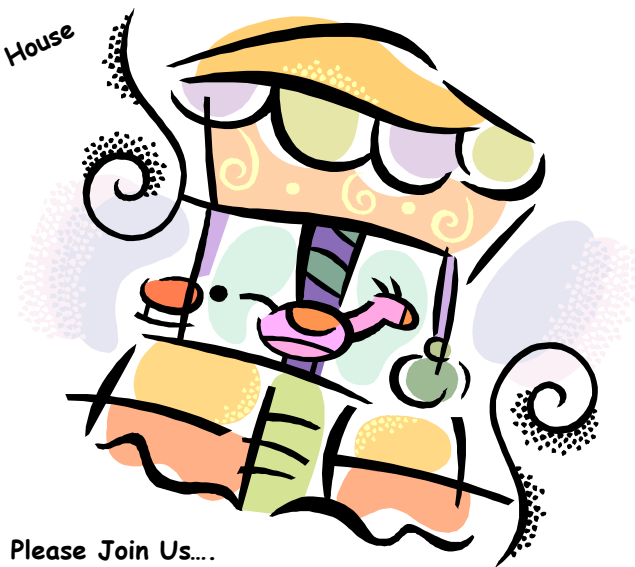
Safe Route to School Project

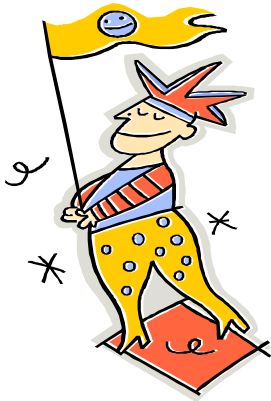

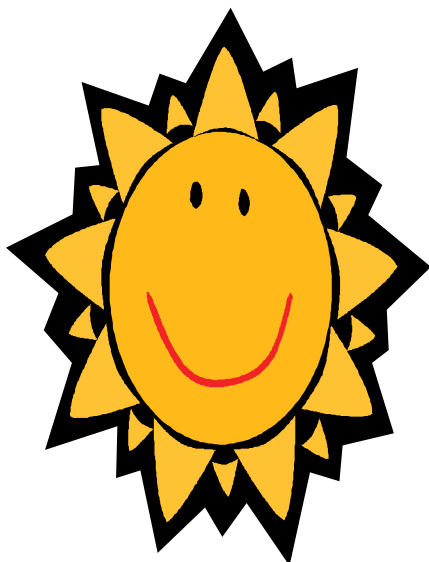
